

## MANDATORY POSTING OF SCORES

Adjusted gross scores (home and away) must be reported by the player along with the appropriate USGA Course and Slope ratings. Away scores made in any US state or in a foreign country are to be reported for handicap purposes only if played on courses with USGA Course and Slope Ratings. Posting is made electronically by the player from any device capable of utilizing the Golf Handicap and Information Network (GHIN) application.

A nine-hole score must be recorded every time a player completes at least seven holes. If a player completes 13 holes or more, she must record an 18-hole score. For handicap purposes only, the player must post net par for all unplayed holes. Scores in both match play and stroke play – including those made in multi-ball competition – must be used.

Scores are **NOT** acceptable for posting when:

- Fewer than seven holes are played
- As a condition of competition, the maximum number of clubs allowed is less than 14, or types of clubs are limited (such as a competition using only irons)
- The length of the course is less than 3,000 yards for 18 holes
- The course played is in an area in which an inactive season is in effect (refer to Section 6-2, USGA Handicap System Manual)
- A majority of the holes on the course are not played in accordance with the Rules of Golf
- Scores are made on a course with no USGA Course Rating or USGA Slope Rating
- A player carries or uses non-conforming golf clubs or golf balls
