

PRO POINTS

Description:

The annual Pro Points tournament is a year-long, 18-hole stroke-play event from the Green tees. As closely as possible, a Pro Points competition day is scheduled once each month (usually in conjunction with Putting, Closest-to-Pin and WGANC events). Points are awarded to the players having the ten lowest net scores of the day¹. Points are divided equally for ties. The players having the most accumulated Pro Points at the end of the November receive awards at the Annual Awards Luncheon in December.

Duties of the Tournament Chair:

1. Prior to January, confirm the Pro Points competition schedule and budget with the Captain. (Note: A separate annual budget is established for Pro Points, Putts, Birdies and Chip-ins.)
2. If a Pro Points competition day is cancelled due to adverse weather/course conditions, the event should be rescheduled to the following regular weekly tournament day. Should that new date be cancelled due to weather/course conditions or if it would conflict with a special or major tournament, the cancelled Pro Points event may be deleted from consideration in the tournament-wide points total. Announcements of these schedule changes - including any change in previously announced tee designation (from Gold/Combo to Green) - should immediately be sent to the members via email and posted on the bulletin board in the Ladies' Locker Room.
3. After each competition, determine the points earned during that day's event. If designated by the Captain, announce that day's winners at that day's luncheon. (Do not announce the names of the tournament leaders; this should be a surprise at the Annual Awards Luncheon)
4. Throughout the year, maintain a spreadsheet of members and accumulated pro points
5. Immediately following the final competition day of the year, total each player's accumulated points; provide the Captain with a written summary of the names and pro points totals for the winners (1st through 10th place).
6. Prior to December, work with the Captain to determine the award amounts for each place.
7. If designated by the Captain, announce and present the awards at the Annual Awards Luncheon.

¹ To check your computations, the points awarded for each event should total 55
